All essays must be typed with the following format: a cover page with the author's name, telephone number, grade level and school, parent/guardian (K-12 only), and photo (required for program), 12 point font and 1 inch margin on all sides, double spaced, pages numbered. Essays will not be returned.

Word limits by division:

College: Maximum 700 words

High School: Maximum 500 words

Middle School (6th-8th): Maximum 350 words

Elementary (1st-5th): 100-250 words

All essays must clearly focus on the assigned theme:
